Districting and Representation Committee

11.30.22

At 2PM, Chair Fritter called the meeting to order and instructed the Secretary to note those present.

Chair Fritter paused for public comments. Mr. Terry Fritter noted that it was this week in 1970 when United Farm Workers President Cesar Chavez was arrested and jailed for two weeks.

Committee reviewed the submitted suggestions for district placement of employees.

General agreement was heard that Colleen Rhode-Szudy be moved to District 86 and Holly Johnson be moved to District 18.

Mr. Wright-Racette moved, seconded by Ms. Miranpuri, to approve the submitted districting assignments and include the two individual recommendations regarding Rhode-Szudy and Johnson. All in Favor. MOTION CARRIED.

Discussion was heard regarding proposal to reduce districts to a total of 99. General agreement was heard in regard to the plan and to review a draft document which would be submitted to Congress in terms of a briefing, with the goal of approving a draft at the next meeting so it could be reported to Congress at their January session.
